The Preserve's amazing biodiversity is reflected in its intricate mosaic of plant communities and associations. The Conservancy has mapped nearly 70 different vegetation types, each housing a special combination of plants and animals. Each of these unique habitats has a valuable function and role, where some of the rarest flowers in California can prosper. The Preserve supports an astounding 440 species of wildflowers — not only beautiful to the human eye but evolved to attract and sustain our precious native pollinators.
